



TEXAS CO-OP POWER HOME ENERGY MAKEOVER

Contest Winner: Peggy Pillar in Boerne

Member of Bandera Electric Cooperative

Peggy Pillar's house has 1,300 square feet of living space and was built in 1993. Pillar has a large family that often visits and sometimes stays overnight. Her guests learned that she sometimes ran out of hot water because her water heater was as old as her home. Further, she knew that her heat pump was also original to the house and learned during a recent service visit that it was need of an upgrade. She recently had the home's exterior painted, and making some indoor improvements was next on her list. She read about last year's Home Energy Makeover contest winners in Texas Co-op Power and decided to enter the contest.



Comprehensive Energy Analysis

WellHome conducted a comprehensive home energy analysis that included a blower door test using diagnostic equipment. They determined that more than 20 percent of the air moving through the old heat pump's duct system was lost due to leaks, holes and poorly connected ducts. This created high energy costs and decreased comfort. WellHome suggested that air sealing, attic insulation and a new heat-pump system would be among the most cost-effective improvements.

Heating and Cooling System

Lennox Industries provided a Model XP14 3-ton-capacity heat pump with SEER 15 efficiency to replace the existing 18-year-old system and included a programmable touch-screen thermostat that allows for temperature and dehumidification settings. WellHome installed the new heat pump and replaced the old thermostat. WellHome carefully sealed the ducts with a mastic sealant and insulated exposed surfaces. The new, higher-rated system and the duct-system sealing enhancements will greatly improve the home's comfort and lower the utility bills.

Insulation with Air Sealing

The insulation in the attic and walls was inadequate in some areas and missing in others. Diagnostic testing showed that there was air flowing through gaps in the insulation and outlets. WellHome increased the attic insulation's rating from an R-24 to an R-49 efficiency level. Also, they identified and sealed all significant wall, ceiling and floor penetrations caused by plumbing and electrical wires that allowed air to infiltrate the home's building envelope.

Water Heater

Bergheim Plumbing provided the labor to upgrade the existing 18-year-old water heater with an 85-gallon Rheem Marathon high-efficiency water heater provided by Texas Electric Cooperatives. It is more energy efficient than other comparable systems and guaranteed for life not to rust or leak.

Pool Pump Efficiency

The home's in-ground pool pump was upgraded by WellHome with a more efficient, programmable Pentair IntelliFlo variable speed pump. The new pump system will dramatically reduce the cost of keeping the pool's water filtered. In addition, the new pump operates much more quietly than the old model in its location just outside Pillar's bedroom window.

Lighting and Water Efficiency

Niagara Conservation donated energy-efficient compact fluorescent lightbulbs (CFLs) as well as water-efficient, low-flow faucet aerators and showerheads that were installed by WellHome. CFLs use 75 percent less energy and radiate less heat than conventional bulbs. The low-flow devices have the added benefit of helping reduce the amount of energy needed to heat water. Niagara Conservation provided do-it-yourself Home Energy Efficiency Kits to each of the contest runners-up to help them begin their own home energy makeover.

Quality Assurance and Quality Control

Building Performance Institute provided a third-party inspection of WellHome's work to ensure that the highest level of industry standards were followed on the project.
